

## **To work in a team spirit (Team as Working):**

**What is mean by the team is everyone who contributes to developing the patient's condition, starting with the patient himself or the patient and his family.**

**In addition to the members of the health team, starting with the doctor and nurse and ending with the service worker, as follows:**

**1-To maintain the professional relationship with his colleagues and the rest of the team members involved in providing health care Developing this relationship in a way that serves the interest of the patient or the reviewer, the nurse must do the following:**

- a. Get to know all team members, including the patient's family.**
- b. Write the addresses and phone numbers of the health team and give them its address and phone number.**
- c. Dealing with respect and credibility with the team.**
- d. Tolerance and try to absorb any misunderstanding or hostility that occurs between him and the team members.**
- e. He made himself a means of strengthening the relationship between team members and not the other way around.**

**2-Cooperating with others to deliver health care to the individual, family and community, nurse do the following:**

- a. Make sure to involve everyone in the health care plan and listen to their point of view.**
- b. Not being stingy with information to the patient or beneficiary, his family, or his fellow health team members.**
- c. Avoid making fun of others' information and skills when giving the information or skill to any team member.**
- d. Offering assistance to others, regardless of the member's academic level, while being simple and flexible.**

**3-Creating a fair and supportive work environment that ensures improving the quality of health care.**

**4-Bear responsibility for professional conduct .**

**Follow the following:**

- a. Accuracy when performing any metric procedure.**
- b. Avoid dealing with the patient like dealing with a machine, that is, the psychological aspect of the patient must be taken into account.**
- c. Avoid exploiting the efforts of others for personal gain, that is, one must avoid selfishness at work. In planning or presenting.**
- d. Admitting the mistake before accusing the nurse or others of committing a mistake Nursing care for the patient or client.**
