- 1-Practicing the nursing profession in accordance with the standards of professional practice in force in the Nursing Syndicate.**
- 2-Expressing an opinion on the standards set for practicing the nursing profession.**
- 3-Treated with dignity and respect by the health team**
- 4-A safe environment, in which all general safety conditions are met•**
- 5-Obtaining comprehensive job service privileges •**
- 6-Representing nursing in specialized committees for formulating nursing and health policies.**
- 7-Knowing the nature of diseases for all patients to whom nursing care is provided.**
- 8-Protection from exposure to any sexual harassment.**
- 9-Expressing to those responsible his refusal to take any actions that he finds inconsistent with his principles.**
- 10-Obtaining confidential consulting services.**
- 11-Belonging to professional councils and associations**
- 12-Reject any action that is inconsistent with the principles of the profession.**
- 13-Discussing any matter related to the profession in particular, and to health care in general, in various councils And the committees.**
- 14-Obtaining wages commensurate with the level of education, experience and skill.**
- 15-Continuing education and skills development.**
- 16-Full knowledge of any case filed against him/her as a nurse, within the period in which the complaint is filed.**
