## worthy and trust:

The nurse performs his work honestly and sincerely so that the patient or beneficiary entrusts him with the matter of his health care and is reassured of He works in his best interest and is trusted. When he has these qualities, he reflects a good reputation for his profession and is in the position of Community trust. To achieve this, the nurse must consider the following:

- **1.**Acting in a way that enhances the reputation of the profession The nurse must know the community about the nursing profession and who the model nurse is through his behavior with the patient and his family And follow the following:
- a. Maintaining a professional atmosphere and not deviating from that.
- **b.**Paying attention to everything that would strengthen and develop his personality, starting with his general appearance and ending with his clothing Professional and ending with emotional stability.
- **c.** Maintaining calm in the workplace and ensuring the comfort of the patient/beneficiary.
- 2. Not to exploit or exploit the relationship between the nurse and the patient/auditor to achieve personal interests.

The relationship with the patient must be aimed at improving his health and recovery, and enabling him to perform his daily tasks to some extent Little by little through:

- **a.** Good reception for the patient or beneficiary, regardless of his .nationality, religion, gender or race Or his political direction.
- **b.**Not distinguishing between patients or beneficiaries in the quality and quantity of nursing care provided to them.
- **c.** Taking into account the severity of the patient's condition and the degree of risk in estimating the quality and quantity of nursing care.

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- **3.** Avoid giving the patient incorrect or misleading information regarding his illness or health condition, as it is often If the patient or his family tries to inquire about the patient, his health condition, or information regarding his illness, then the patient must Take the following matters into consideration:
- **a.** At the beginning of developing the patient's care plan, there must be agreement among the health team members about the patient's care plan And agreement between members of the health team about the information permitted to be disclosed to the patient in the event of Inquire about it.
- **b.** Avoid answering the patient or client with incorrect or uncertain answers.
- **c.** Some answers can be referred to the specialist, taking into account the preservation of private emotions Such as facial expressions and signs that indicate the answer.
